Drägasani wine region

The wine region was named after the town of Dragasani situated right in the heart of the region. Vineyards are planted on the eastern and southern and just rarely on the western slopes of the hills stretching from the north to the south on the western side of the river Olt. The wine region stretches at a length of some 50 km along the river but its width hardly ever exceeds 6-7 km.


