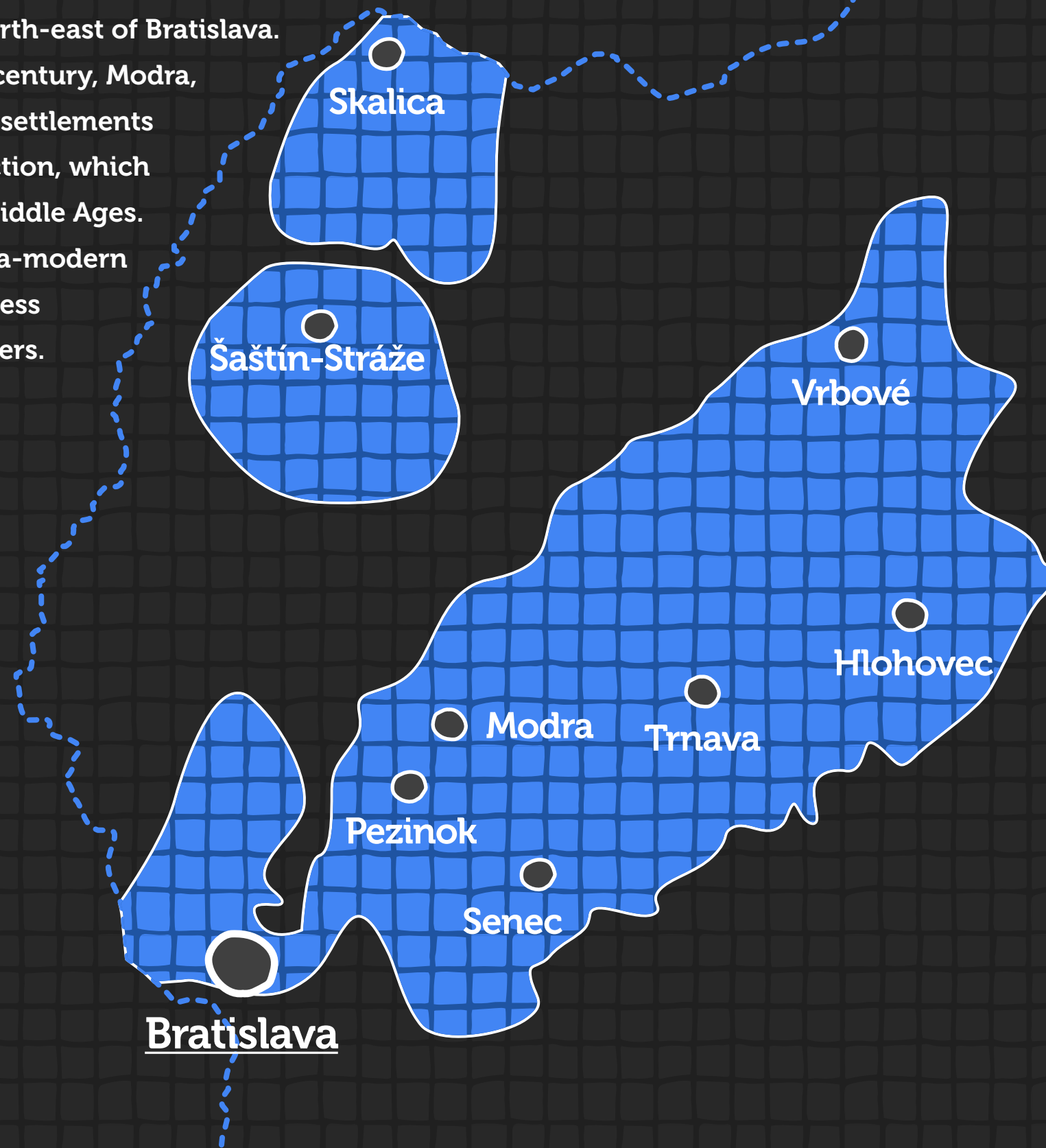

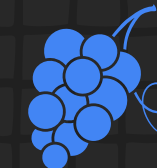
'SMALL CARPATHIAN' WINE REGION
