


Stredoslovenská

'CENTRAL SLOVAKIAN' WINE REGION



Stredoslovenská is the most southern area of Slovakia near the border with Hungary. It is a diverse wine region that stretches from Hont to Gemer. The first written mention of viticulture in this area dates back to 1135, when King Béla II. gave two vineyards to the Benedictine monastery in Bzovík.
